This is perfectly okay if you re-assure your child to do the best they can. Treat the tests as just another thing to do. Don't turn it into a drama, it will only make matters worse. The independent sector has many approaches to selecting pupils, again go to websites for details.

If you cannot access sites come into school for help.

If anything worries you come and ask, no matter how trivial it seems.

Check dates for forms etc so you do not miss any deadlines.

That's about it at this stage, as news emerges we will keep you up to date.
